### Project Manager's Report For the year ended 31 December 2018

Sponsoring Community Workshop on Nutrition is a project being funded by Tear Drops into Joy and Maternal Mortality Action Group from Australia.

The project is intended to educate and train the women on how to provide babies and children the right nutrition to boost their growth and strengthen their immune system in Sra and the surrounding communities.

This has become necessary because of the increase in poor and stunted growth amongs children in the Sra community, due to poor nutrtion.

The total receipts for 2018 amounted to US \$3,023 (Three thousand and twenty- three United States Dollars) equivalent to GH¢14,180 (Fourteen thousand, One Hundred and Eighty Ghana cedis) against an expenditure of US \$900 (Nine Hundred United States Dollars) equivalent to GH¢ 4,412 (Four Thousand, Four Hundred and Twelve Ghana cedis) leading to a cash balance at close of 2018 of US \$ 2,923 (Two thousand, nine hundred and Twenty-three United States Dollars) equivalent to GH¢14,089 (Fourteen Thousand, and Eighty-Nine Ghana Cedis.
